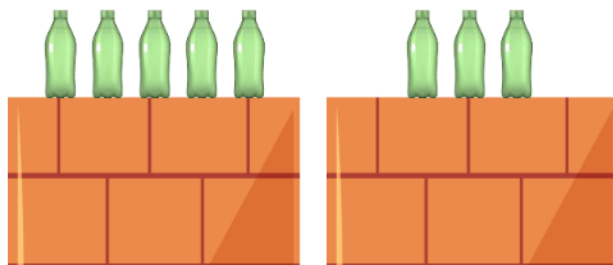


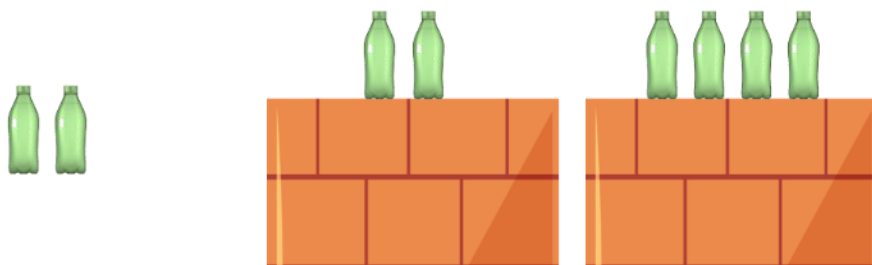
Number Bonds within 10

Bob has 8 bottles that he can put on two walls. He has written 5 different number bonds that he can create with his bottles.



$$5 + 3 = 8 \quad 1 + 7 = 8 \quad 6 + 2 = 8 \quad 4 + 4 = 8 \quad 0 + 8 = 8$$

Explore the other ways the bottles can be put on the wall to create number bonds up to 8. You do not have to use all of the bottles.



Write all of the number bonds for each total.

Various answers, for example:

$$2 + 4 = 6$$
