

Subtraction – crossing 10 (2)

- 1 Jack has 11 apples.
Mo has 5 apples.

Jack	11
Mo	5

How many more apples does Jack have than Mo?

Tick the number sentence that answers the question.

$$11 + 5 = 16$$

$$11 - 5 = 6$$

- 2 Eva has 13 sweets.
Teddy has 6 sweets.

How many more sweets does Eva have than Teddy?

$$\boxed{13} - \boxed{6} = \boxed{7}$$

Eva has $\boxed{7}$ more sweets than Teddy.

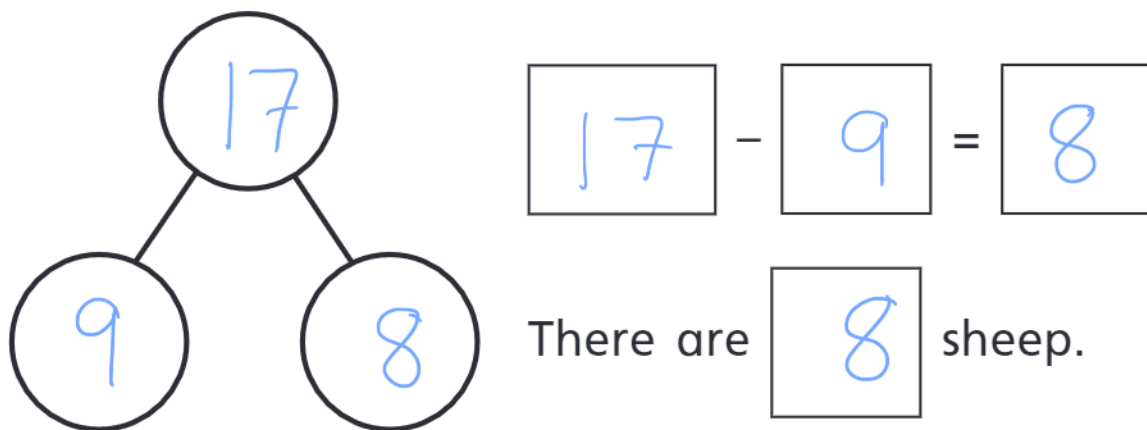


3 There are 17 animals on a farm.
